

Adult Canine and Feline Vaccine Protocol

We recommend that you annually vaccinate your pets. When you bring your pet in for its annual vaccines our doctors will do a thorough wellness exam on your pet as well.

Annual Vaccine for Dogs:

Wellness Exam

Rabies Vaccine – A three year vaccine but all surrounding counties require it be done annually.

Canine Distemper Parvo

Bordatella Vaccine – Kennel Cough

Heartworm/Ehrlichia/Lyme Test

Fecal – Check for Intestinal Parasites

Annual Vaccine for Cats:

Wellness Exam

Rabies Vaccine – A three year vaccine but all surrounding counties require it be done annually.

Feline Leukemia Vaccine

FVRCP Vaccine – Respiratory Vaccine

Fecal- Check for Intestinal Parasites

During our annual exam our doctors check your pet's mouth for tartar and periodontal disease. We recommend your pet's teeth be cleaned and polished annually.

For our Senior Pets, 7 years and older, we recommend that we do blood work to check all their levels. This will show us how their kidneys and liver are functioning, their blood sugar levels, and thyroid levels. If we monitor these for our senior pets this will allow us to help keep them comfortable and treat them before their levels are harder to get under control.
