

# Our Puppy Vaccine and De-worming Protocol

2-3weeks old - 1<sup>st</sup> Deworming

6 weeks old - First visit to Doctor

- Complete Physical Exam
- Fecal Exam, check for intestinal parasites
- Canine Distemper/Parvo vaccine
- Deworming (In clinic)
- Free 1<sup>st</sup> dose of Heartworm Prevention (Puppy Pack)
- Begin Flea Prevention

10 weeks old - Second visit to Doctor

- Complete Physical Exam
- Canine Distemper/Parvo vaccine
- Deworming (In clinic)
- Heartworm Prevention
- Flea Prevention

14 weeks old - Third visit to Doctor

- Complete Exam
- Canine Distemper/Parvo
- Canine Bordatella (Kennel Cough)
- Rabies
- Heartworm Prevention
- Flea Prevention

6 months – Spay or Neuter Puppy

After last set of puppy vaccines your pet will need to come in annually for his/her annual vaccines and heartworm test and fecal with free in clinic deworming.

A dental check is always done when we do the annual vaccines. We recommend all your pets have an annual dental cleaning.

Disease prevention is the most cost effective protocol for all your pets. The Parvovirus treatment alone can cost you \$350 or more, while the series of vaccinations will only cost you around \$60-\$75.
